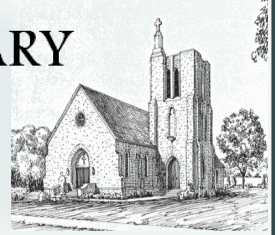

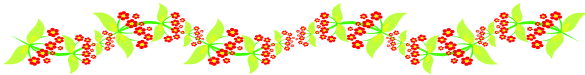

From Rosie's Desk -

Thought I would give an update regarding Shepherd's Crossing. It's been a while since I've reported. Started in 2001, as the brainchild of a group of ministers from local churches of which I was a part of, Shepherd's Crossing provides compassionate and caring assistance to those in need of a listening ear and financial support. This ecumenical non-profit organization offers budget counseling, referrals, and financial support for rent, utilities and prescription medications to low-income families with financial emergencies. It serves people from all walks of life, regardless of religious affiliation. Volunteers contribute more than 2,700 hours annually, much of this devoted to client counseling. Our parish is represented on the Board by Kathy Buyle. Facilities are provided rent free by the First United Methodist Church.

In 2014, Shepherd's Crossing distributed \$222,500 in support of 1,596 households. To date, it has served more than 4,500 households and distributed more than \$1.5 million dollars to the poor and marginalized. Each year, 30 to 40 churches, along with a dozen civic groups and hundreds of businesses and individuals support this ministry. Seven Dolores Parish and The Family Centered Budget Shop are among the churches that send a monthly contribution. Thank you to all who support Shepherd's Crossing. It is a VERY good opportunity to share your treasure!
