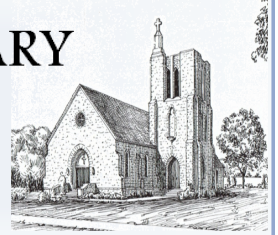

NOVEMBER PARISH INTENTION: For the deceased of our parish, and in thanksgiving for all they have entrusted to us.

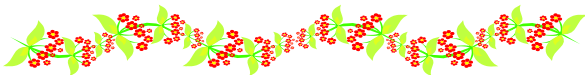
