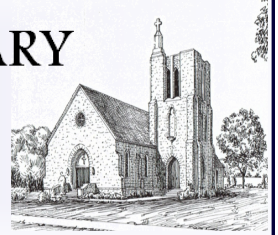

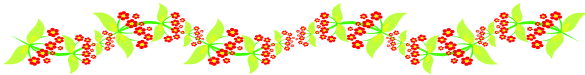

## SALINA DIOCESE RESPONDS TO "SPOTLIGHT"

As you may have noticed by now a new film, "Spotlight," which portrays the Boston Globe's Pulitzer-Prize-winning 2002 coverage of the Massachusetts clerical sexual abuse crisis, will open nationwide. We anticipate the release of the film will bring renewed interest, media coverage and questions regarding clerical sexual misconduct with minors.

Clerical sexual abuse of minors is a tragedy and a painful chapter in our faith, especially for the victims of abuse and their families. The Diocese of Salina has taken decisive steps in preventing clerical sexual abuse through our Safe Environment Program, which began in 2002. We are proud to say we have policies and protocols in place that deal with this issue head-on. The Church has struggled with the sexual abuse crisis for many years as depicted in the film, "Spotlight." However, the story told in the film is not our story.

We have in place a multi-faceted, comprehensive approach to addressing this issue and our efforts have been effective in stopping virtually all clerical sexual abuse of minors since 2002. What's more – our effort and commitment are ongoing.

The abuse of any child is a crime and a sin. The Diocese encourages anyone who has been sexually abused by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee, to come forward to law enforcement, the Department of Children and Families and/or the Victim's Assistant Coordinator. 
