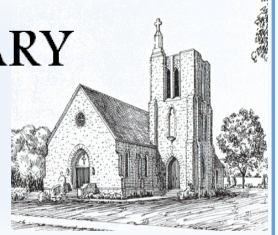

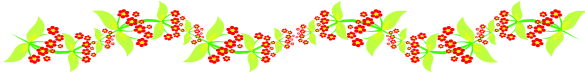

STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT

"John answered them all, 'I baptize you with water; but he who is mightier than I is coming...he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit...'"
 Luke 3:16

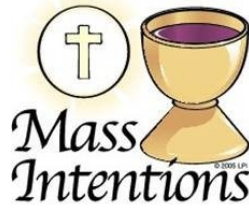

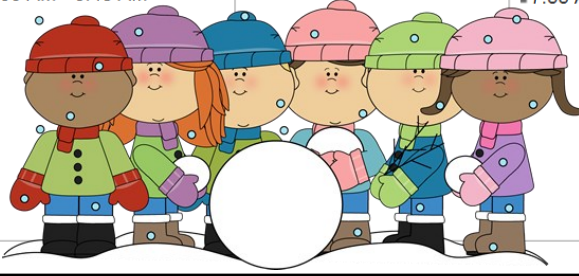
