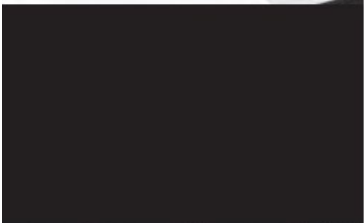


ADULT CONFIRMATION
