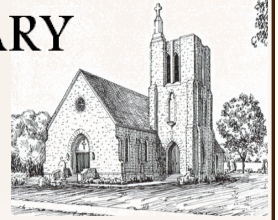

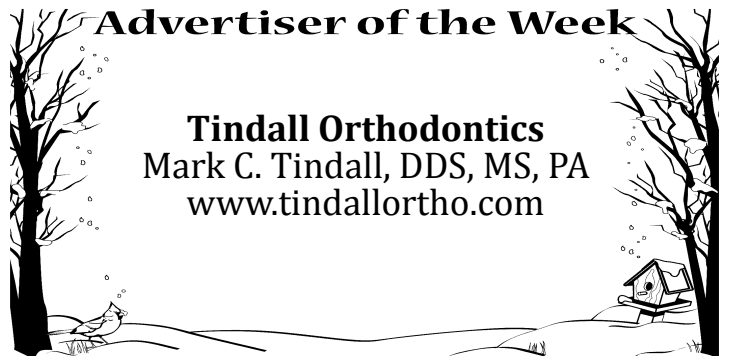
RCIA

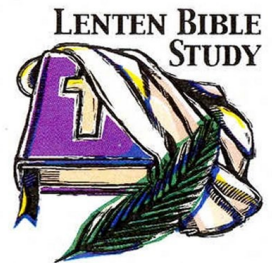
