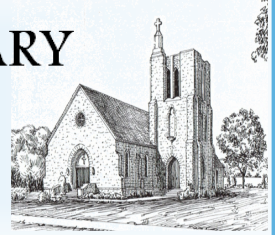

Today we have listened to Bishop Weisenburger's message about the Catholic Community Annual Appeal that is kicking off this week. You will soon be receiving a letter from Bishop Weisenburger inviting you to make a gift to the Appeal. This year's theme is ***Open the Door to Mercy***. Please prayerfully consider supporting the work of the Church throughout our Diocese as you reflect on your many blessings.



Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has declared from December 8, 2015 until the end of November, 2016, to be a year of mercy, a time to be aware of God's mercy to us and to extend this mercy to all. As a way to make this concrete, he has challenged us to focus on the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. The word "corporal" means "body" and thus these works help others meet another's physical needs, e.g., hunger. The spiritual works of mercy assist others to meet the deep needs of our souls, e.g., sound advice when hurting. In the coming weeks, we will list in the bulletin some examples of concrete ways we can exercise these works.

Rally For Religious Freedom

Wednesday, February 17th - Noon - 1 PM

The Catholic Bishops of Kansas and other organizations will be hosting a ***Rally for Religious Freedom*** inside the Kansas State Capitol Building, in the 2nd Floor Rotunda area. A large turnout is encouraged to demonstrate to Kansas lawmakers that support for religious freedom in Kansas is strong. Speakers include Ryan Anderson of the Heritage Foundation, one of the "Houston Five" pastors whose sermons were subpoenaed, the owner of a flower shop being prosecuted for declining to participate in a same-sex wedding ceremony, the President of the March for Life, and Governor Sam Brownback. Free parking for the Rally has been moved to Judicial Center Lot #4 at the corner of Topeka Blvd. and 12th Street. This lot is within walking distance of the Capitol.

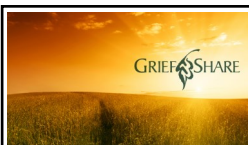
