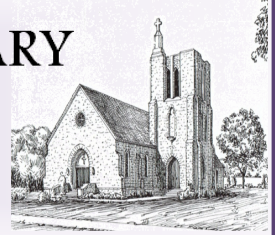
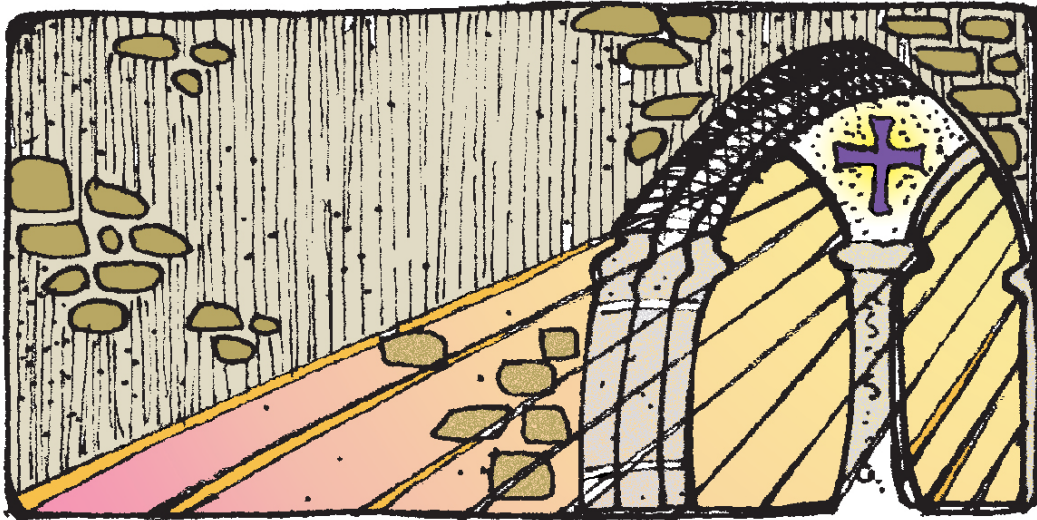

Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has declared from December 8, 2015 until the end of November, 2016, to be a year of mercy, a time to be aware of God's mercy to us and to extend this mercy to all. As a way to make this concrete, he has challenged us to focus on the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. The word "corporal" means "body" and thus these works help others meet another's physical needs, e.g., hunger. The spiritual works of mercy assist others to meet the deep needs of our souls, e.g., sound advice when hurting. In the coming weeks, we will list in the bulletin some examples of concrete ways we can exercise these works.

*What do I want or need to say to God?*  
(ex. "Thank you.", "I'm sorry.", "I'm embarrassed that I...", "I don't understand.", "Help me to...", "I sometimes thought that you were helping me grow, but I don't know where you will lead me.", "What do you want me to do?")

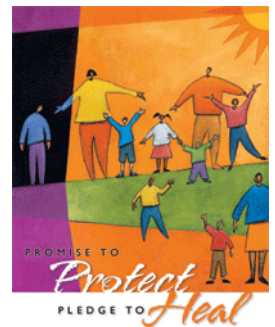

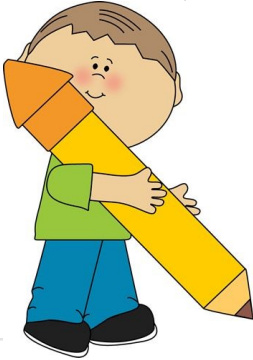

## MCS CAMPAIGN UPDATE: The Renovation Committee

has been meeting with Patrick Schaub, architect of BBN Architects. They have planned the renovation into two phases. On February 11, the architect and members of the committee met with the Bishop and his oversight committee. They gave us permission to proceed with Phase One. The first phase will begin this summer and will include repairing the roof, replacing the exterior windows, updating technology and repairing the bathrooms. Cost estimate for Phase One is \$588,000. To date MCS Capital Campaign has received total pledges for \$1,010,674. In addition, another \$973,455 has been pledged to the school through Seven Dolors campaign for a total of \$1,984,129. Of that total, we have already collected \$1,055,465. THANK YOU.
