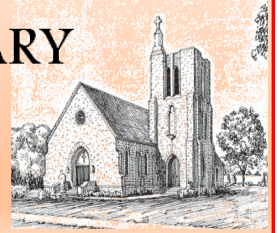

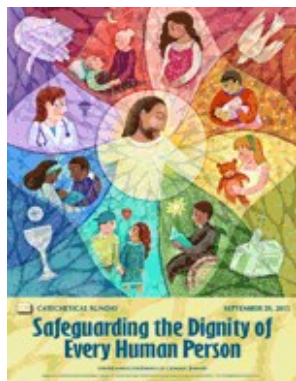


Budget Shop Donation Room is now closed for the summer

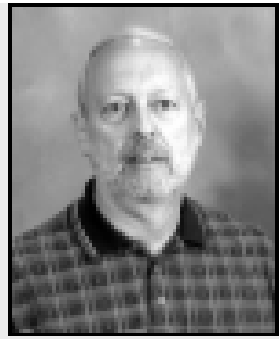
