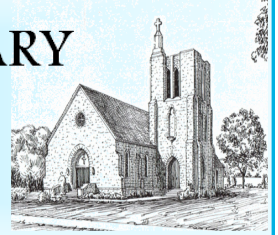

Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has declared from December 8, 2015 until the end of November, 2016, to be a year of mercy, a time to be aware of God's mercy to us and to extend this mercy to all. As a way to make this concrete, he has challenged us to focus on the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. The word "corporal" means "body" and thus these works help others meet another's physical needs, e.g., hunger. The spiritual works of mercy assist others to meet the deep needs of our souls, e.g., sound advice when hurting. In the coming weeks, we will list in the bulletin some examples of concrete ways we can exercise these works.

CORPORAL WORKS OF MERCY

Bury the Dead

ACT:

- 1. Attend wakes and funerals, even if you are not familiar with the deceased person.*
- 2. Donate to and/or support the local hospice program.*
- 3. Reach out willingly to those near you who have had someone die recently.*
- 4. Include widows/widowers in your circle of friends.*
- 5. Learn about the Communion of Saints and keep your deceased friends and relatives in mind.*
- 6. Volunteer to help serve meals for funerals in your parish.*
- 7. Send a Mass card to a bereaved person.*
- 8. Visit a bereaved person and share uplifting stories about the deceased.*
