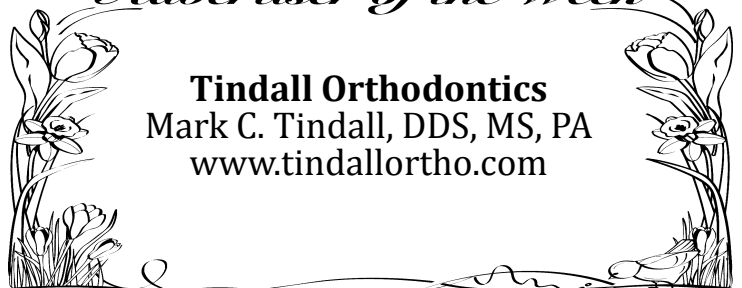


Make plans to join Bishop Weisenburger for a dinner and meet the Seminarians of the Diocese of Salina.

Thank you for supporting Manhattan Catholic Schools with the Capital Campaign. We are beginning building renovations at the elementary school this summer.

BBN Architects have good plans for our renovation and BHS Construction has started abatement of windows and flashing. Manko will be providing a new window system for our school. BHS Construction will repair the roofs, install or repair soffit and fascia, replace electrical lines, replace the front doors, complete some general repairs, install some drywall and paint some of the interior and exterior parts of the building. Next summer will see the completion of the windows in the Luckey building, HVAC in the elementary building and hopefully new lighting/ceilings and flooring in both buildings.
