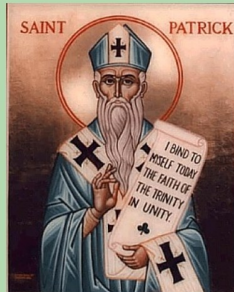

We encourage you to make this the “best Lent ever!” Some ideas are daily Mass, attending Friday Stations of the Cross or joining a Small Group – a small community of faith – to discuss the Sunday readings or the themes of Lent. This year, we again will provide each family one of two resources: The Word Among Us or the “The Little Black Book.” Why not join a Small Group OR form one for yourself with your friends or family? Our parish is offering a small group utilizing the resources found on FORMED.org called “Forgiven – The Transforming Power of Confession” that will meet Tuesday mornings or Thursday evenings. There are other Small Groups in that have been active in the Parish: Monday morning at 9:30 am and Monday afternoon at 2:30 pm in the Parish Center; Tuesday Noon at Meadowlark with Circle 6; Wednesday afternoon at 1:15 pm; Wednesday evenings at 7pm. Thoughts on the Women's Conference from Deacon Wayne Talbot

“The Women’s Spirituality Conference has taken place in Manhattan for several years now and has brought in some very good speakers. I would say the speaker they have chosen for this year is one of the best. Sr. Edith Prendergast is a Religious Sister of Charity who was born in Ireland. She entered religious life in 1959 and undertook studies in theology. She served as director of the Office of Religious Education at the Archdiocese of Los Angeles for more than 25 years. It was in that capacity that Sr. Edith directed what is known as the Religious Education Congress, which gathers almost 40,000 participants annually in Anaheim, CA. Several of our staff have attended (along with a few folks from our diocese) and have come back inspired. Sr. Edith usually gave the opening address at every congress and delivered a message of enthusiasm for those gathered. She was one of the first non-clerical people to hold a Director of Religious Education ministry in a U.S. diocese. Her energy and passion for the formation and ongoing education of youth and adults brought some very notable Catholic speakers to the congress. I have to say that the organization that moved that many people effectively over the course of three days was incredible. You could tell that she loved the richness and diversity of Catholicism and wanted to share that with all the participants. It is a tremendous privilege that our women’s group landed a speaker with such loaded talent and background. I believe it speaks to the way this local women’s spirituality conference has grown. Please take advantage of this opportunity to hear and experience a passionate woman of faith. The ladies who plan this event spend many hours organizing it to make it happen. LITURGY CORNER



Seven Dolors has the reputation of being a “singing parish!” What a wonderful reputation! Do you sometimes wonder how the music is chosen for the weekend liturgies? We use several resources and music is planned for the liturgical seasons and feast. Know that the music isn’t just picked because someone likes the song! A lot of time, effort, and theology goes into the song choices. Maybe you’ve noticed sometimes that the Offertory song “picks up” a verse from the readings or maybe follows what theme of the homily is. That isn’t by accident. One item of interest: the Responsorial Psalm should always be sung. The cantor introduces the refrain of the psalm the first time and the assembly responds by themselves after each verse. So if you notice the cantor “stepping back” at the refrain – that’s your part! Liturgical singing enables us, the Body of Christ, to enter more fully into ritual enactment of the Paschal Mystery. The “what’s and “how-to”s of music ministry are then developed from this perspective. Singing can form us in a paschal mystery spirituality that shapes daily Christian living and makes the relationship between liturgy and life more evident. So each Sunday, be aware of the song choices and make the connection in YOUR life.



Rite of Election

The whole parish is invited to the RITE OF ELECTION on Sunday, March 12 in Salina at Sacred Heart Cathedral at 3p.m. Our Catechumens and Candidates will participate in this next Rite in their faith journey. The reason we celebrate this ritual is given to us in the introduction to the rite: “...Thus the Church makes its “election,” that is, the choice and admission of those catechumens who have the dispositions that make them fit to take part, at the next major celebration - the sacraments of initiation.” (119). This choice is made by the Church (headed locally by the bishop) as an outward expression of the choice already made by God. Only those catechumens who are “fit/able/qualified” are chosen to enter into the final phase to join the Church. Those chosen are expected to be initiated into a life in Christ, which necessarily means of a life of mission.
