5. To serve all people with dignity and respect

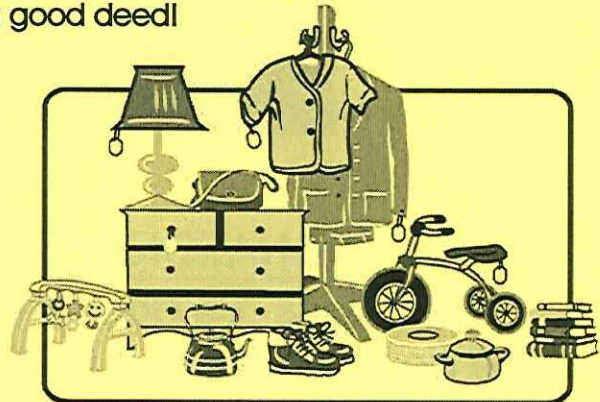
Annual Report

The Budget Shop had another good year, thanks to our dedicated volunteers, contributors and clientele. We are under the sponsorship of Seven Dolors Parish. Our income enables us to help more people and give more to our parishes and other agencies.

We try to keep operating expenses down but it costs about \$7,000 annually.

From August 2016 to December 2016, we have honored 96 vouchers serving 269 men, women and children. The value of the goods received was \$3890.00. Vouchers were issued by the Flint Hills Breadbasket, Shepherd's Crossing, Catholic Charities, Headstart and the Seven Dolors Parish Center.

After we closed in June 2016, Larry Nordstrom delivered a trailer load of clothing and other items to the St. Joseph Indian Mission in South Dakota. Joe Nilges helps out with the daily recycling to help save our environment.

We provided/donated:

- ♦ many dolls and toys for the Toys for Manhattan Christmas project
- ♦ prom apparel for Flint Hills Job Corps students
- ♦ materials for projects that benefit our community

Volunteers

We have 56 volunteers working in the back room preparing items for sale five mornings a week and an additional 50 serving as retail staff monthly. Our dedicated crew, comprised of parishioners from Seven Dolors, St. Thomas More and the community have an enjoyable time sorting, storing, pricing and displaying items.
