## *October: the month of the Holy Rosary*

On October 7, we celebrate a well-loved memorial in honor of the Rosary, and according to a long-standing tradition, the Church dedicates the entire month of October to the Most Holy Rosary. In the Rosary, with its sequence of prayers and mysteries, we contemplate the Gospel in company with the Blessed Virgin Mary. As St. John Paul II wrote in 2002, "the Rosary. . . is a prayer loved by countless Saints and encouraged by the Magisterium. Simple yet profound, it still remains, at the dawn of this third millennium, a prayer of great significance, destined to being forth a harvest of holiness. . . . With the Rosary, the Christian people sit at the school of Mary and are led to contemplate the beauty on the face of Christ and to experience the depths of this love. Through the Rosary the faithful receive abundant grace, as though from the very hands of the Mother of the Redeemer" (Rosarium Virginitatis Mariae, 1).

## RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

We continue to gather in the church basement during and after the 10am Mass each Sunday. Each week we invite YOU to join in the spiritual journey of our candidates and catechumens. One of our couples just welcomed a new baby boy. Blake and Brittany Vierya have started their faith journey with us, only to continue it when they move to California. You will get to officially meet them when they receive the Rite of Acceptance in November.

The RCIA is a pastoral plan for our parish and a ritual process through which the Church welcomes and forms adults in the way of Jesus as it is lived in the Roman Catholic tradition. It enables our parish to see itself as a welcoming and initiating community. The value of our parish community is that it clearly reminds us that it is a living faith into which we are welcoming new members – which is why you are asked to drop in on the lessons after the 10 am Mass. # Shepherd's Crossing



Coming up soon for Shepherd's Crossing is the C. Clyde Fun Run/Walk on October 28. You can register online at [cba.k-state.edu/cclyderun](http://cba.k-state.edu/cclyderun), email [mhorton@ksu.edu](mailto:mhorton@ksu.edu) or call Shepherd's Crossing. Entry fees are \$20 for students, \$25 for non-students, \$10 for children under 16 and \$20 each for teams of four or more. There are brochures in the back of church.

Shepherd's Crossing assisted 166 households in August, including 101 households with utilities totaling \$16,881, 15 with prescriptions totaling \$785 and 50 with rent totaling \$31,059.24. Volunteers gave more than 225 hours advising on budgets and other resources and help the clients feel welcome. Shepherd's Crossing is the emergency agency – last hope – that aids in rent, utilities assisting Riley County, Manhattan, and St. George. Thank you for your kind generosity and financial support.

from Our Common Home: Pope Francis' Encyclical, *Laudato Si*:

"Living our vocation to be protectors of God's handiwork is essential to a life of virtue; it is not an optional or secondary aspect of our Christian experience."

We are called by Pope Francis in *Laudato Si* to make a change in lifestyle and consumption. Thus, we assume our responsibility to care for and protect our gift of God's creation. Here are two easy steps from Greenfaith that all of us can attempt this fall/winter:

**Quick Step #1:** Adjust your thermostat one degree: Through energy use alone, the average US home creates over 13 tons of greenhouse gas emissions annually – the same amount as driving a car over 12,000 miles. Right now, turn your thermostat one degree higher (if you're still using air conditioning); one degree lower for this winter.

**Quick Step #2:** Make your lunch or dinner today a vegetarian meal: Meat production worldwide is a leading source of greenhouse gas emissions, and creates huge amounts of toxic waste. Animals are often treated with terrible cruelty on factory farms. Today make your lunch or dinner meat free. Visit [Vegetarian Times](http://Vegetarian Times) for meat-free recipes.

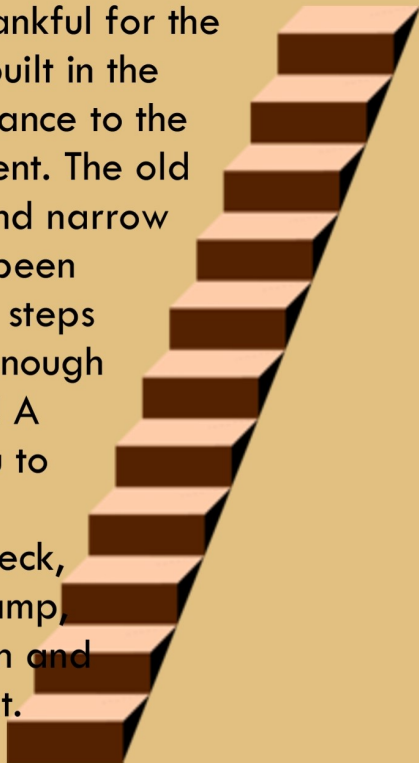


# New Dishwasher!

## Deanery Liturgical Event

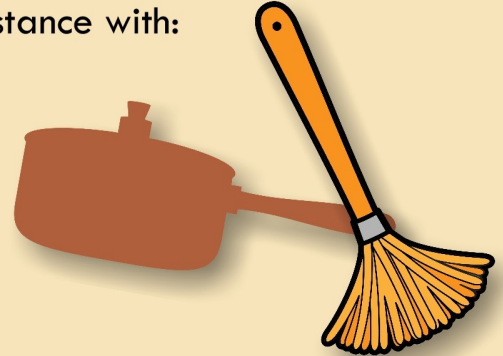
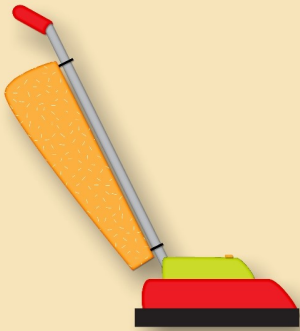
