August: The Month of the Immaculate Heart of Mary

The month of August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart. Since the 16th century Catholic piety has assigned entire months to special devotions. The month of August is traditionally dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The physical heart of Mary is venerated (and not adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love (especially for her divine Son), virtue, and inner life. Such devotion is an incentive to a similar love and virtue. This devotion has received new emphasis in this century from the visions given to Lucy Dos Santos, oldest of the visionaries of Fatima, in her convent in Tuy, in Spain, in 1925 and 1926. In the visions Our Lady asked for the practice of the Five First Saturdays to help make amends for the offenses committed against her heart by the blasphemies and ingratitude of men. The practice parallels the devotion of the Nine First Fridays in honor of the Sacred Heart. On October 31, 1942, Pope Pius XII made a solemn Act of Consecration of the Church and the whole world to the Immaculate Heart. Let us remember this devotion year-round, but particularly through the month of August. (Excerpted from The Prayer Book by Reverend John P. O'Connell, M.A., S.T.D. and Jex Martin, M.A.)

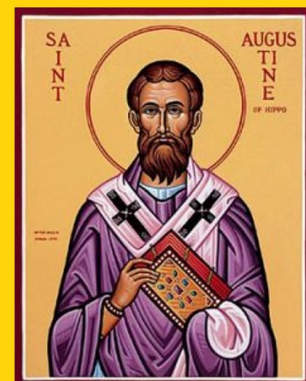

MANHATTAN CATHOLIC COMMUNITY CONNECTED

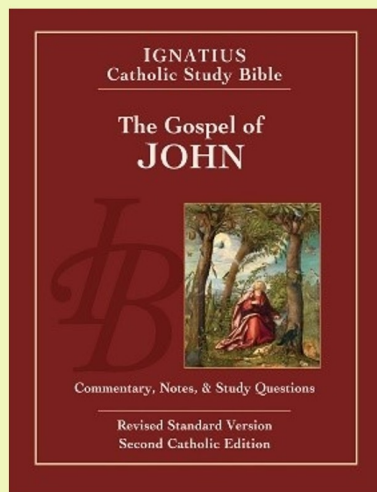
Manhattan Catholic Community Connected, or MC3, is a newly formed cooperative organization consisting of members of the three area parishes: St Isidore's Catholic Student Center, St Thomas More Catholic Church and Seven Dolor's Catholic Church. Over a hundred and fifty members of these parishes came together on the evening of July 9 for the inaugural MC3 Summer Social at Blue Moose.

Fr Frank Coady, Pastor at St. Thomas More Church, Fr Gale Hammerschmidt, Pastor and Fr. Ryan McCandless, Parochial Vicar at St. Isidore's Catholic Student Center and Fr Kerry Ninemire, Pastor at Seven Dolors Catholic Church attended the event and encouraged their parishioners to enjoy an evening of fellowship and a presentation by Dr. Bernard Franklin, Special Assistant to the President at Kansas State University.

The stated purpose of MC3 is "Together, we seek to grow in faith, build fellowship and impact identified needs in the Manhattan community." The next MC3 event is planned for Monday, November 5 at Blue Moose. The planned speaker is Jennifer Risper, former women's NBA player, who will tell of her experience on the Camino de Santiago, her faith journey, and her current job with FOCCUS (Catholic College Evangelization movement). After that, on Monday, March 4, our new bishop-elect Gerald Vincke, has been invited to speak. This will be a great opportunity for our local Catholic community to meet him and hear his message. These events are pending but mark your calendars now.



BIBLE STUDY



In an effort to provide Bible Study opportunities for our parish, The Gospel of John will be offered by Bill Kifer, who has facilitated this study in his previous parish. This 6 week study resource from Ignatius Press, includes a study guide that will further your understanding of this Gospel. 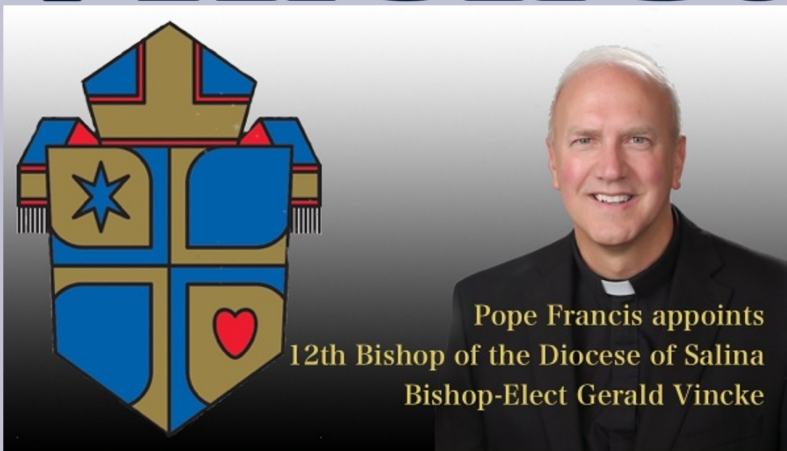

Lucille is a retired school teacher. She has been a member of Seven Dolors Parish since 1978. Lucille says "To me, Stewardship means doing my part to make the world a better place. I believe that God has put me here for a purpose and each day needs to be lived toward that end. Stewardship involves giving of Time, Talent, and Treasure. 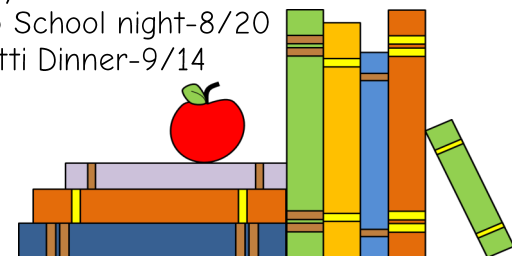

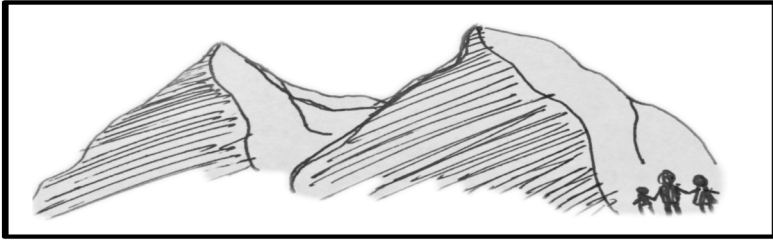
