How do we continue our support for and reliance on the Church in the face of such disappointment? This is a kind of grieving for a lost trust, an attitude about the Church that has now failed us. So, what is left? To whom can we reach out for support? To each other. We need to talk about this openly, in a dialogue that could help us discover that we can support each other in our sense of loss. St. Thomas More Parish is offering such a dialogue. On Sunday, October 7, at 7 pm, in the Utopia Room, we are inviting parishioners of all three Manhattan Catholic parishes to come together to talk openly about this crisis. All three pastors will be present. This is not so much to provide answers or solutions, and especially not excuses. It is a coming together to talk honestly, to own the issue, and to find support in one another.

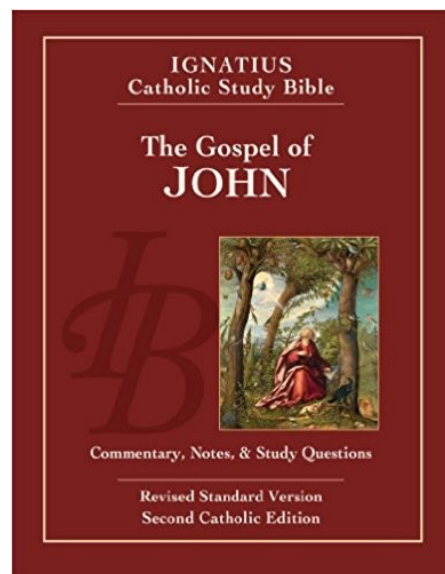
## Parish Choirs
