†**Mass for Human Trafficking Victims:** Via Christi Hospital here is offering the First Wednesday regular Noon Mass for Human Trafficking Victims. The Mass is in honor of St. Bakhita, the designated saint of Human Trafficking, who was herself such a victim. St. Josephine Bakhita was born in Sudan in 1869 and enslaved as a child. Eventually sold to an Italian diplomat and taken to Italy, she was later brought to freedom through the Canossian Daughters of Charity. Through their guidance, she learned about God and served him faithfully until her death in 1947. In October 2000, she was canonized by Pope John Paul II, in which he noted that "in St. Josephine Bakhita we find a shining advocate of genuine emancipation. The history of her life [shows] the firm resolve to work effectively to free girls and women from oppression and violence, and return them to their dignity in the full exercise of their rights." The Hospital Chapel is on the north side of the 1st floor between the two hospital main entrances.

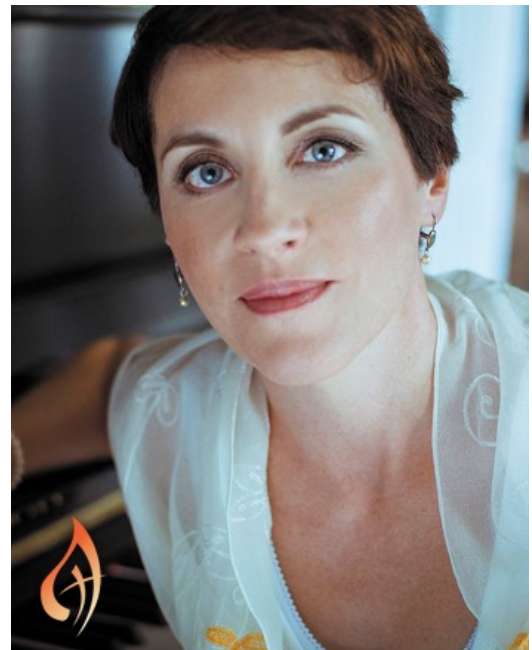
†**Ministry Schedule:** Margie is getting ready to start on the new Ministry schedule for March-May. Please visit the scheduler to update you availability.
