LENTEN THOUGHTS

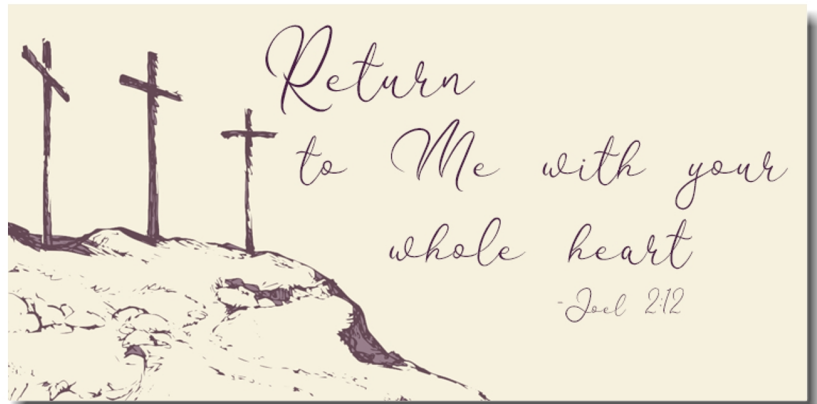

Holy Week 2019



Though it's only the first of April, we need to start thinking of how to observe the holiest week of the year!

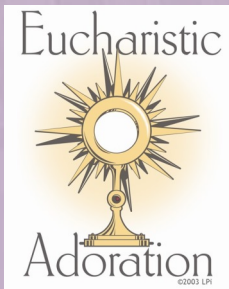
The Chrism Mass is Thursday, April 11 at 11:30 am at Sacred Heart Cathedral in Salina. The Holy Oils for the whole diocese will be blessed by Bishop Vincke. This year, Easter Sunday is April 21.

The Holy Week Schedule is as follows:

HOLY THURSDAY	Mass of the Lord's Supper	7:30p.m.
GOOD FRIDAY	Celebration of the Passion of the Lord	Noon and 7:30p.m.
EASTER VIGIL	Vigil Mass	8:30p.m.

Easter Vigil is a special liturgy in which our RCIA candidates come into full Communion with the Church. As multiple sacraments are received, it is a longer and joy-filled celebration. Shattering the darkness, the great Paschal candle is lit with the Easter fire, five wax nails of incense are embedded, and it becomes the symbol of the crucified Christ. The Paschal Mystery, already celebrated in various ways since the Mass of the Lord's supper, is clearly and joyfully announced from the very beginning of the Vigil liturgy. It is through the light of the Paschal candle that the liturgy continues to unfold. The Easter Vigil is considered the most beautiful of all liturgies by many. If you've been watching the catechumens and candidates through this year, this is a wonderful time to be present and surround them with our support. We want to invite you to celebrate with us beginning at 8:30 pm on Saturday night, April 20th. We begin outside around the Easter fire. What better way to end the penitential season of Lent? So put on your Easter clothes, take off your watch and join with Seven Dolors parish as we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus!
(Please Lord, no rain!)

The Adoration Chapel will close for the Triduum at 4 pm on April 18 and reopen Easter Sunday at 1 pm.

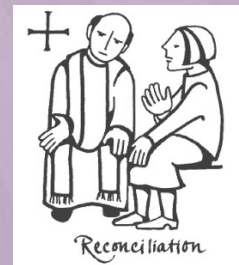
