Book of the Month

I recommend *A Grief Unveiled* by Gregory Floyd. Author Floyd is a very Catholic husband and father with a theology degree. He and his wife, Maureen, lost a seven year old child to a tragic accident in 1995. The child was playing outside their home and was struck by a car. He bravely deals with the questions of God and suffering, the impact of the death on other siblings and shares from his heart the bitter stages of grief. Throughout the book, he shares very beautifully but realistically how his faith was their support and guide. The last chapters share his reflections 10-15 years later. I liked best that he was just very, very real and yet a man of deep faith.

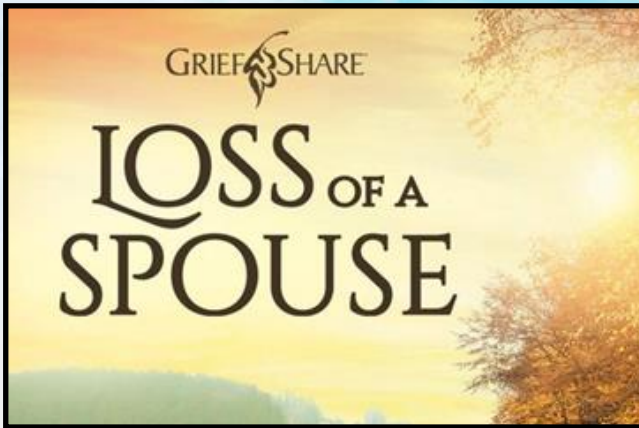

God is calling YOU (& us) on an adventure this year. Our parish desperately needs 10 – 12 catechists (women AND MEN) for the Religious Education programs for 2019-2020 – to help our youth more fully become and stay Catholic.

Perhaps the first thing you said after reading that sentence was, “That’s not me.” And yet, **IT IS.**

Consider these three examples from scripture of people just like you (and us) who were called to specific missions by God and what they said, at first:

“Do not be anxious about how or what you are to answer or what you are to say; for the Holy Spirit will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say.” (Luke.11b,12)

Jeremiah - “Sorry God, I’m just not old enough to help You.”

Moses - “God, I’m not a public speaker.”

Samuel - “Someone keeps calling my name. Am I making this up?”

In each case, they doubted their call from God and at first said – that’s not me. Yet, they HAD a call from God and once they accepted, they were blessed. However, they COULDN’T carry out God’s call on their own so God provided someone who would help them – the Holy Spirit. He will help you too God just needs your YES – guaranteed! Answering God’s call only requires our YES to Him.

Parents have the greatest responsibility, and by means of each child’s baptism, we as a community share in this responsibility as well. So, how can you help? Start first by making yourself available to God’s call.

Pray right now please, that God will help you answer His call to be a catechist even though you don’t see how you can. And come see one of us soon so we can talk.

Pastoral Council July Minutes

The Seven Dolors Pastoral Council met on Monday, July 15.

Delores Thomas said that the electric bills are going to be slightly higher, while the gas bills will decrease. Scalora and Associates said this is to be expected with the new systems. The portico at the rectory was recently painted, with the work being donated by a parishioner. The fundraising for the Mary Garden at the parish center was a success. Delores also informed the council that the church basement has been offered to serve as a shelter for victims displaced by any future flooding.

Fr Kerry gave an update of the Capital Campaign, saying that there is \$50,000 left to pay for the School's campaign, and \$130,000 left to pay for the Church's.

Pat McCoy reported that the "Cardinals Summer Camp" continues to go well and is showing signs of being an overall successful venture. The first day of school is August 14th, with the Back to School Picnic being held the Sunday before. School days this coming year will be from 7:40-2:55 to coincide with the changes made by USD 383.

Tammy Pachta said that the next Catholic Formation meeting is August 5th.

Jolene Amtower reported that the Parish Picnic will be on September 15th at the Sunset Zoo.

Lucille Johnson told the council that the Arts on the Green will take place on August 25th from 6-8:30. All funds raised will go to Annunciation House.

The Salina Diocese Council of Catholic Women met in Clay Center on Thursday, July 25th. All 4 vicariates were represented. Father Daryl Olmstead opened the day with Mass and then a rosary was recited. The Clay Center Catholic Women's Organization hosted coffee, juice and rolls after the devotions. The meeting, conducted by president Pat Erickson, included reports from Legislative, Church & Community, International, Family, and Organization Commissions. Father Daryl also showed slides of his trip to Rome and other places in Italy. Lunch was served by the Clay Center CWO. After eating, the meeting reconvened. It was passed to send \$150 to Water for Life under the Catholic Relief Services, and \$1000 to the Salina Diocese Seminarian Fund. The 2020 Convention will be held Aug. 29th in WaKeeny. The group tentatively chose Sarah Hart for the keynote speaker. The next board meeting will be Oct. 5th in Hays or Russell. The SDCCW Workshop will be in Beloit on Jan. 26, 2020. Before leaving for home the group recited the Divine Mercy Chaplet in the church.
