St. Joseph Adoration Chapel News

Eucharistic Adoration has been a great blessing to many holy people. The following quote comes from St. Padre Pio
"We must always have courage, and if some spiritual languor comes upon us, let us run to the feet of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, and let us place ourselves in the midst of the heavenly perfumes, and we will undoubtedly regain our strength."

The St. Joseph Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration Chapel is located at 731 Pierre St. It is a "community adoration chapel" for all three parishes in Manhattan and St. Patrick's in Ogden. It is important to have commitments from all the Catholics in Manhattan and Ogden, in order to maintain "unceasing adoration" for the 25th year.

Contact Linda to sub periodically or to take an hour at 785-341-2574.

A second adorer or prayer partner is needed for several hours. In this situation, you already have your sub, should you not be able to be there. You simply check with your prayer partner to make sure they will be there. Second adorers are needed for the following hours: Monday 9 am and 3 pm; Thursday 3 pm and 11 pm; Friday 12 am.

Vacant unfilled hours are: Friday 2 am and Saturday 3 am.

If you are willing to sub periodically, call Linda at 785-341-2574. When an adorer needs a sub, an email will come to you. If you can sub, follow the directions. If you cannot, simply delete the email. It's a great way to try out the adoration chapel without making an hour per week commitment.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

Seven Dolors offers a complete Religious Formation Program for Pre-K through 12th Grade. This includes the preparation and celebration of **First Reconciliation** and **Communion** (2nd Grade) and **Confirmation** (8th Grade). We meet Wednesday evenings from 6:30-8pm.

Registration for the 2019-20 school year begins August 5.

There are several ways to register:

- Returning families who pre-enrolled in the spring will receive an email from the Religious Education Office with further instructions.
- Visit the sevendolors.com website to complete the online Registration Form. Payments can be made at final registration/first day of class on August 28. You will not need to print anything (This is located under the Office of Parish Religious Education Department)
- Visit the sevendolors.com website to find the Registration Form, Form B and HIPAA to complete and print.
- Stop by the Parish Office for paperwork

If you are printing forms, they can be mailed to or dropped off at the Parish Office.

****For children receiving sacraments, you will need to fill out a Sacrament Information Form (found on our website or at the parish office) and submit a certified copy of the sacraments your child has received.**

RCIA

Anyone who knows me, knows the theology behind how we offer RCIA. We're not training theologians, we are forming Catholic Christians – active parishioners. With this in mind, I have attended several workshops over the years, the last one being July 2-3 at Loyola in Chicago. It was sponsored by Liturgical Training Publications. In meeting with other RCIA Directors throughout the United States, ranging in parish size from 5,000 families to 300 families, the theology behind what we are doing here at Seven Dolors has been reaffirmed. Here's what we would like to now see happen at Seven Dolors: **a team of parishioners to help this process flourish.** Now, we know that making a commitment for EVERY Sunday is a little much so what we would like to see formed is FOUR teams of 3-5 parishioners, each assigned consistently to only one Sunday at a time. These four teams would have the same Sunday each month – 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th and would attend the regular session after the 10am Mass on Sundays. That way, you would only make a commitment once a month. I am having a meeting about this on Thursday, August 22 at 6:30 in the Parish Center for those of you who are interested in finding more about what a team member does. If you have read our bulletin blips about RCIA over that last several years, you know that it is NOT a class but an apprenticeship model where there would be a presentation then an opportunity to share OUR faith and how that impacts our lives, families, workmate, etc. Please pray about this opportunity! Answer the call!
