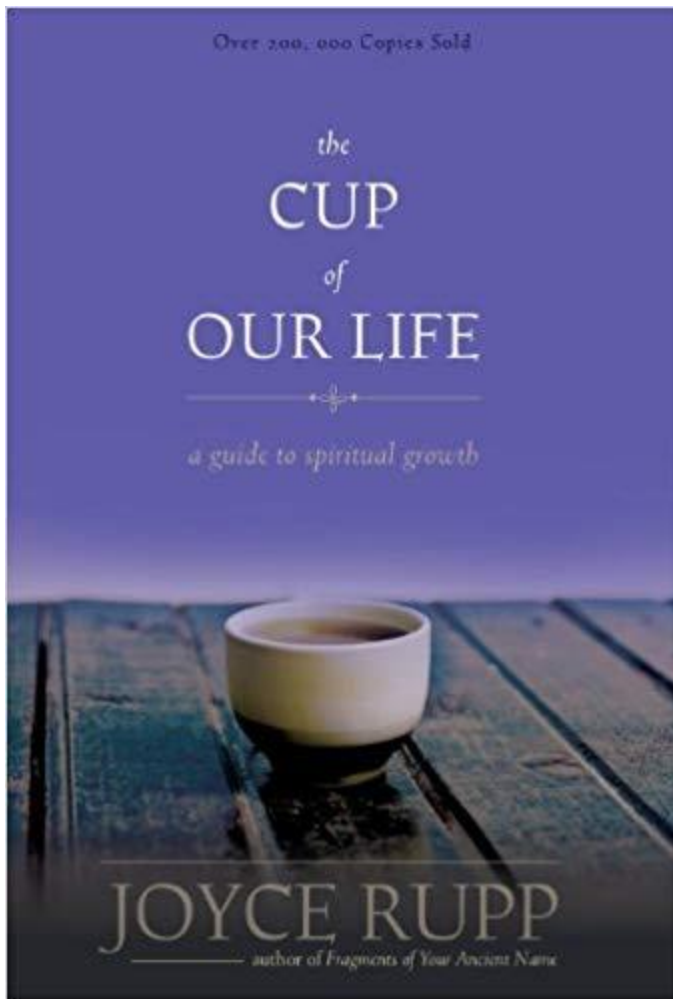

The *Cup of Life Workshop* is a six week spiritual journey following the contemplative prayer practice outlined by Sr. Joyce Rupp (Servant of Mary) in her book, "The Cup of Our Life: A Guide for Spiritual Growth."
