We want to welcome Josh Leon and Linda Hellbush who celebrated the Rite of Acceptance last Sunday. Now they will begin the next period for RCIA call the CATECHUMENATE. This is an extended period which they are given suitable pastoral formation and guidance aimed at training them in the Christian life. In this way, the dispositions manifested at the acceptance into the catechumenate are brought to maturity. During this time, “a suitable catechesis is provided by catechists, deacons, priests, or other of the faithful, planned to be gradual and complete in its coverage, accommodated to the liturgical year, and solidly supported by celebrations of the Word. This catechesis leads the catechumens and candidates not only to an appropriate acquaintance with dogmas and precepts but also to a profound sense of the mystery of salvation in which they desire to participate.” (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, 75.1)

Descriptions of Liturgical Life Roles

HOSPITALITY/USHER: These ministers are responsible for greeting members of the congregation as they enter the church, help with finding seats, finding volunteers to take up the gifts, and taking up the collection. They also distribute the weekly bulletin after Mass and prepare the pews for the next service.

SACRISTAN: Sacristans assist the priests by making sure the candles for the altar are filled and cleaned. Other duties may be assigned as required, based on the liturgical calendar.

Descriptions of Parish Life Groups and Commissions

SOCIAL ACTION: The Social Action commission supports and encourages our parish to act for positive change at local, national, and global levels through service, education, witness and advocacy. Examples of past activities include recycling, assistance to hurting people locally and on the border, right-to-life, and Arts on the Green.

PARISH LIFE: This commission is set up to provide opportunities for parishioners to provide ways for parishioners to come to know and enjoy each other. In this way, they seek to deepen our parish unity. To date, examples of their activities are the Parish Picnic and the Birthday Dinner.

EVANGELIZATION: The purpose of this commission is to promote the Good News of the Gospel in our parish in all possible ways. Their special focus is to reach out to new parishioners. They have also assisted with Parish Missions and RCIA.

FORMATION: The purpose of this commission is aiding in the planning and implementation of learning opportunities for Seven Dolours. They work with the RE and CYO Directors to choose curriculum for their classes, and lend assistance to Manhattan Catholic Schools. They also work to provide continuing education opportunities for all ages in the parish.

PARISH NURSE COMMITTEE: Parish nurse ministers provide the link between traditional health care and spiritual health. Their role is to promote health and wholeness of the community within the context of faith. Examples of past activities are blood pressure checks after Mass, informative inserts on various health topics, etc.

RCIA: If you are interested in being a team member or sponsor, your information will be passed on to Rosie Rundell, Director of RCIA, and she will be in contact with you.

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS: The Knights of Columbus is a National fraternal order within the church. The men meet monthly and host events such as: The Annual Chicken BBQ, monthly breakfasts after Mass, Fish Fry during Lent, Right-To-Life events, and many more.

SEVEN DOLORS CATHOLIC WOMEN: Or SDCW for short. The women provide support and host events for the parish. Some of their events include: Monthly donuts after Mass, the Women's Spirituality Conference, BUNCO night, Funeral Dinner support, and many more.

PRAYER SHAWL: This is a group of parishioners who knit or crochet shawls and blankets for those in need. They have donated over 20 shawls to the KBI Crimes Against Children Task Force, to provide comfort for victims. You do not need to know how to knit or crochet; the members of the group are more than happy to help you learn!

OVER 50'S: This group is open to all members of the parish over the age of 50. They hold monthly get-togethers with Mass and potluck lunches. The group also organizes and attends day trips and other activities.
