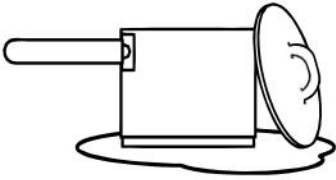
AROUND THE COMMUNITY
