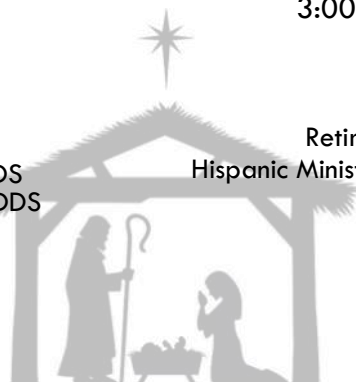

The Parish Staff would like to introduce a new monthly article called "Gratitude Spotlight." This month we show our gratitude to our Social Action Commission. This group of parishioners fully embraces the Corporal Works of Mercy on a daily basis. While they are well known for their work with the "Arts on the Green", their full list of activities is much longer. At the beginning of each liturgical year, they encourage the members of the parish to share their hope and thankfulness. Parishioners do this by purchasing gifts for local residents in need and young adults who are leaving the foster care system. During Lent, members bake loaves of bread, which are then sold. The proceeds from these sales are sent to Annunciation House in El Paso, TX to help those seeking asylum here in the US. The Social Action Commission is also responsible for the "Going Green" movement here at the parish. They have worked to place recycling bins at MCS for both the school and parish to use, and their enthusiasm regarding this program has led the parish staff to be more conscience of their recycling habits at home and work. This year, the members of the commission have worked with the Ogden Friendship House to host Community meals at the St. Patrick's church hall. They have hosted several meals, all with great success, and free of charge to the Ogden community!

This group of parish volunteers truly does their best to do all for the greater glory of God and do as Christ has told us.
