## *Called & Gifted*

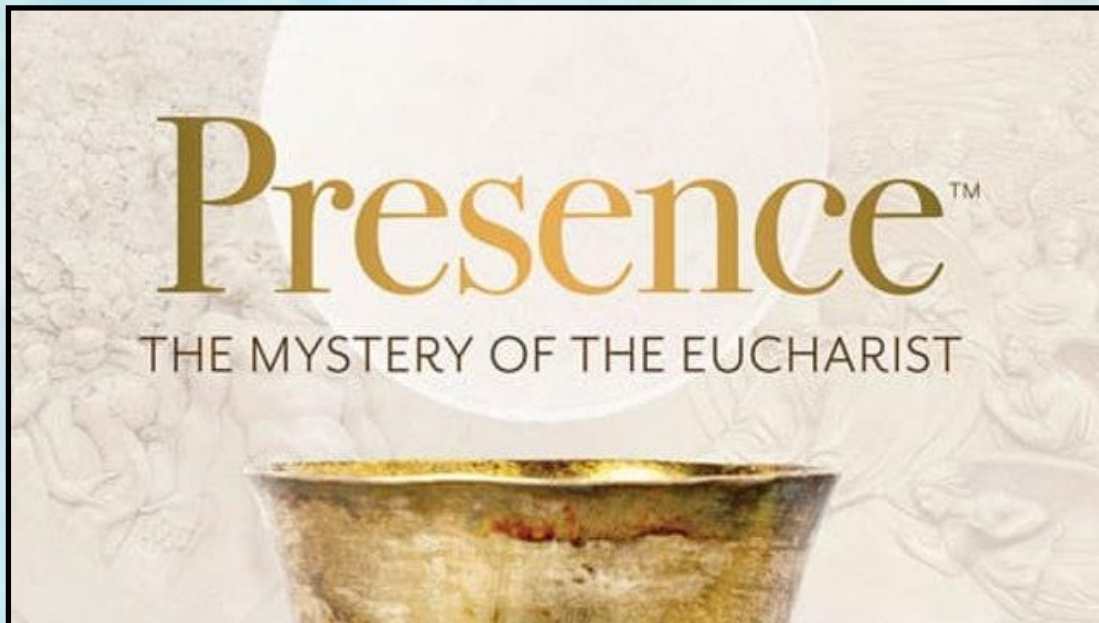

At communion time, go directly to the cup minister standing nearest the hymn board and indicate your desire for a gluten free host by pointing to the gold bowl, to be followed by the cup if that is your wish.
