This increase will only be possible with the help of volunteers. Our Mobile Outreach program delivers over two hundred food boxes and hygiene bags to the parking lots of the Catholic Churches in Clay Center, Junction City, Herington, Abilene, Chapman, Mankato, and Washington each month. The amount of time required to accomplish this is significant. Volunteers would learn how to assemble boxes and bags, inventory stock and place orders, as well as shop for necessary items ... all while gaining the satisfaction of helping our neighbors in need. 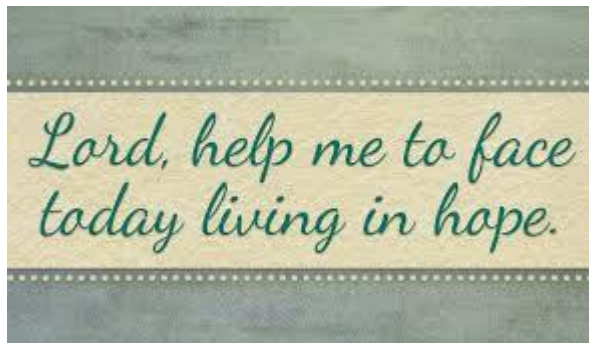
