SACRAMENTS

- First Communion - Grade 2 – Must be enrolled in and attending Religious Ed
- Confirmation - Grade 8 – Must be enrolled in and attending either Religious Ed or MCS. If enrolled at MCS, you will also need to complete a registration form the Confirmation program.

Todas las inscripciones deben ser completadas y entregados en la oficina parroquial antes del 9 de Septiembre.

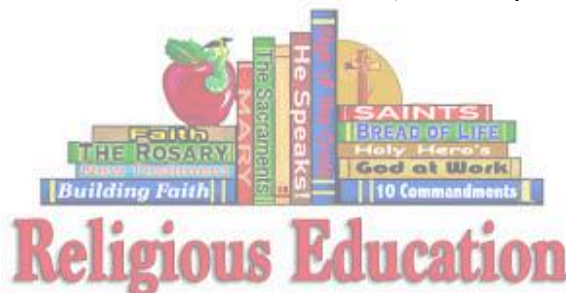

*Vol-un-teer - a person who freely offers to take part in an enterprise or undertake a task willingly and without pay.

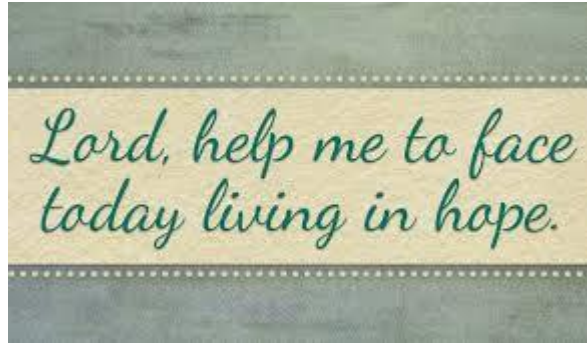
