Our book of the "living dead" will be placed in front of the Blessed Virgin Mary statue. In this book you may inscribe names of your deceased, especially those of recent memory.

†**St. Paul Street Evangelization** is an organization working with God for the salvation of souls through the proclamation of the Gospel in the public square. The Church exists in order to evangelize. Evangelizing is in fact the grace and vocation proper to us and should be our deepest identity. St. Paul Street Evangelization proposes a personal relationship with Christ as key to complete fulfillment. 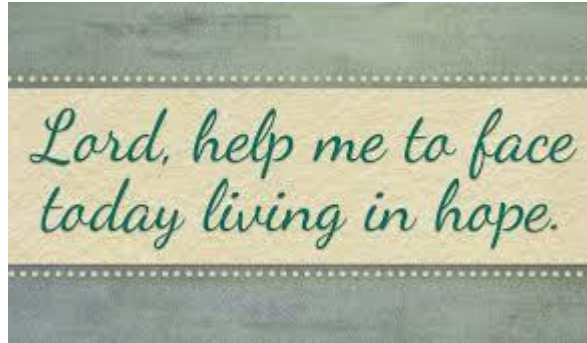
