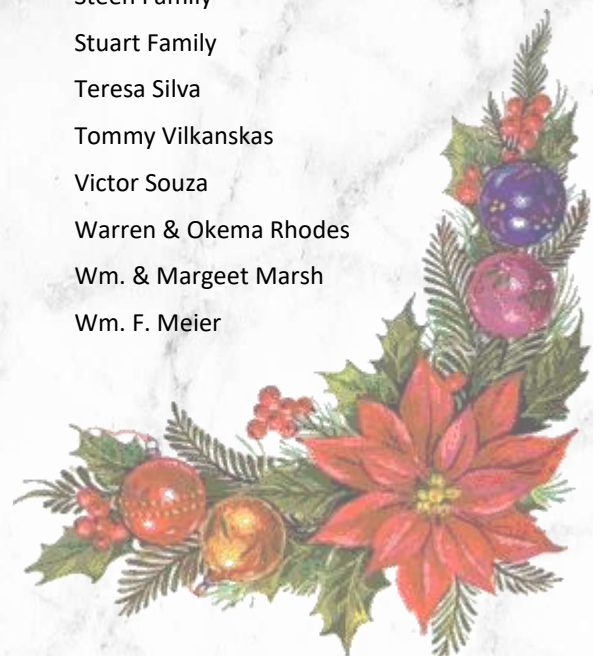

# A MESSAGE FROM THE SOCIAL ACTION COMMISSION

Pro-Life Care of our Common Home

Epiphany is just a start, a reminder, we too were once migrants or refugees.

With refugee numbers the largest ever, (80MM worldwide) and so many being parents with children (40% are under 18), we **need** a pro-life response.

With climate conditions a fostering factor, scripture, Pope Francis' encyclical *Laudato Si* and many of our saints offer direction we need.

#1: Develop awareness of, then gratitude for how much we have. St. John of the Cross: "The first step in growing spiritual life is to grow our gratitude to God because all resources, all life, is gift." St Paul, "In everything give thanks. This is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus."

#2: Knowing how much you have helps you reduce your use. Find a groove-- a mantra-- that helps you identify what are needs and what are wants. Then take only what you need in this world. Our depression-era parents helped us. Irish Granny Alma often said, "There won't be any pockets in your shroud."

What they did, we can emulate. They took fewer, shorter baths, did laundry in large batches, hung out clothes to dry, turned off lights, turned down the thermostat at night and used less AC, shared one car for six people, ran errands in batches to save trips and gas, grew a garden, planted trees, bought fewer clothes, and were out-of-style without a care. With one fourth today's income, they still shared money and time with their neighbors.

#3: Accept we are responsible to be salt and light. In Fr. Flannigan's words, (founder of Boystown, NE), "the care of the innocents is in our hands." And, Jesus..."the greatest in the Kingdom is the servant of all."

Bottom line? Now is not the time to say we're too late. What difference do I make? We serve an awesome God. What you do inspires me to consume or waste less and it inspires me to care for my neighbors more. We are, after-all-- pro-life together.
