+Pro-Life in the time of Covid:

Because of travel restrictions, many people are not going to Washington DC for the annual Right to Life March, they are coming to us. The USCCB Secretariat of Pro-Life Activities is inviting Catholics across the country to observe a nationwide prayer vigil from Thursday, January 28 to Friday, January 29 marking the 48th anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's 1973 decisions Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton. The vigil will be live broadcast beginning at 7 PM Central Time on Jan. 28 from the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. tune in on either the Basilica website or usccb.org. Bachelor of Arts in Pastoral Ministry

The degree student participates in the classes, does assignments, takes exams and receives grades and credit from Newman University. The degree student may complete a degree with a Pastoral Ministry major; or the degree student who already has a college degree may earn a second major (degree).

Diocesan Diploma in Pastoral Ministry

The student pursuing a Diocesan Diploma participates in the classes, does the assignments and takes the exams. The student is enrolled at Newman University as a special student. The student receives grades and college credit for the courses, but does not pursue a degree with a Pastoral Ministry major.

Personal Enrichment

The student reads the assigned materials and participates in the classes, but is not obligated to complete written assignments or take exams. The personal enrichment student does not receive college credit for the courses.

THEO 2023 Theology of the Church (3 hour course)

THEO 4881 Is Fr. Frank Racist?

Instructor: Fr. Frank Coady, with Kevin Willmott. Racism is not just a sin; it is sin. It participates in that original alienation from God and from each other that is allegorized by our first parents in the Garden as well as by the Tower of Babel. It is the desire for separateness, for comparison between the sexes and the races. We are called to a continuing conversion: the call to restore the original unity as well as to long for and work for the ultimate unity which is the Kingdom.

Conversion is an ongoing process. We are periodically called to a deeper awareness of our sin. Likewise, we are called to deeper conversion: letting go of current attitudes in order to make way for reconciliation with God and with God's people.

The course will, with non-judgment and humor, help us to see our own failures so that we can not only be healed but also be agents of reconciliation.

Fr. Frank Coady, STD, is pastor of St. Thomas More Parish, Manhattan, KS, and Director of the Offices of Liturgy, Deacons, and Lay Ministry Formation of the Diocese of Salina. He received his bachelor's degree in philosophy from St. Thomas Seminary College, Denver, and an S.T.L. degree in fundamental theology and Doctorate in dogmatic theology, from Pontifical Gregorian University, Rome.

Kevin Willmott is Professor of Film at the University of Kansas. He is also a filmmaker and writer. Last year, he won an Academy Award for the screenplay for *BlackKlansman*. His current cooperation with Spike Lee, *Da 5 Bloods*, is available on Netflix. He grew up in a mixed neighborhood in Junction City, and graduated from St. Xavier High School and from Marymount College, Salina. He earned the MFA at New York University. He lectures widely in the U.S. and Europe.
