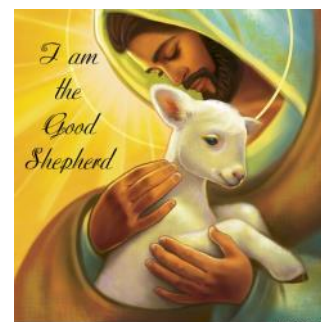

# “When in Our Music, God Is Glorified”

What a year this has been and through it all, we continued to have music for our recordings and live Masses. How did this all happen?

Selecting and planning music for all Masses is completed weeks ahead of time and this same process continued during the pandemic. This is to give the musician's time to practice and prepare for their scheduled masses. Since we were recording each week and used worship aids during Holy Week, copyright laws also had to be followed and reported.

Recording of the weekend masses occurred on Friday afternoons. A cantor was assigned in leading us in music during the recording.

The weekend masses involved more cantors and instrumentalists. These musicians were scheduled 4-6 weeks out and each of them did two or three masses the weekend they were assigned.

The first week in March, the Parish and youth choirs started back with weekly rehearsals to prepare in leading the Parish back into singing on Palm Sunday, Holy Week and Easter using worship aids.

Today, the books are back in the pews, the numbers are posted on the hymn board and now we can go back to being a “singing parish.”

A special thank you goes to all of these musicians who made the Masses in the past year feel normal. The time they gave on Friday afternoons, Sunday mornings and at/during practices was over the top.
