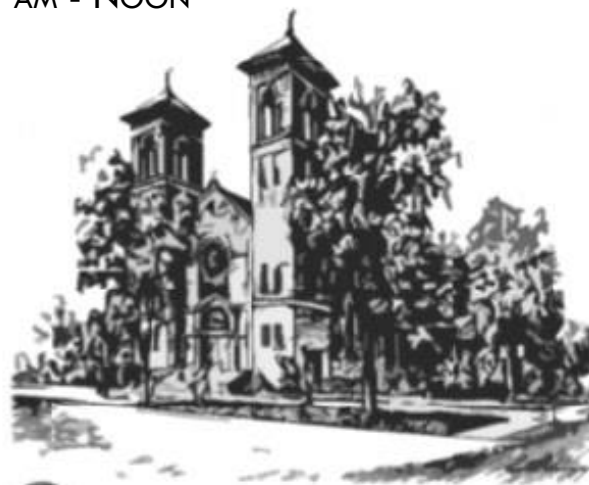

- Preserve safeguards that require the abortion industry to protect women with important clinic safety standards

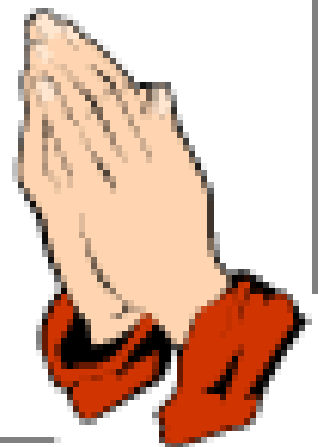
