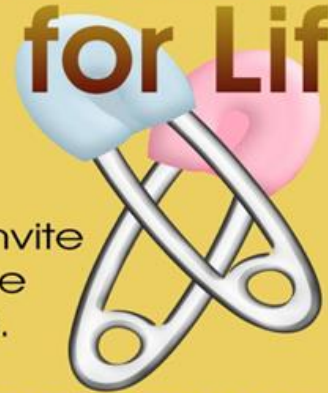
## Catholic Charities Update



