Throughout the month of June we will be hosting the Diocesan Summer Mission Program, Prayer and Action. The team of six college aged youth will be leading college and high school aged youths in our local area to clean yards and paint houses during this summer month. It's a great opportunity for the youth throughout the diocese to grow in their faith by offering charitable work in our community. The group is currently looking for projects to be tackled in these next few weeks and are happy to arrange with homeowners to meet about particular problems and solutions. The group is in need of various tools to be used during the month, some of those tools are ladders, scrapers, paint brushes, rollers, various yard tools (clippers, sheers, weed eaters, etc..), and anything else that may be needed for home improvements. The work is done at no cost to the homeowner, except for the opportunity to share their space and their story with some great youngsters growing in their faith.

Prayer and Action continues to make a tremendous impact on our Diocese and is a worthwhile investment. When you talk to any of our youth who have participated in past Prayer and Action's they'll tell you of their growth in friendship with others, and most importantly with God. It began in 2006 through the idea of Fr. Gale Hammerschmidt who was a seminarian at the time. Manhattan was one of the first locations that Prayer and Action began and has since taken off as a successful mission program in other Dioceses in the country. The parish is invited to participate in numerous ways. First of all, to pray for those who will be attending these weeks, as each week new participants arrive. Second, provide hospitality. This can look like snacks, or a warm welcome, or seeing a group of kids working in a yard and just stopping by to see what they are up to. Third, come and see. Each day the participants will attend the parishes' daily Mass and prayer, come and join in prayer with the young church. This is going to be an exciting summer with lots of hard work and prayer. Let's help each other out in this charitable endeavor.

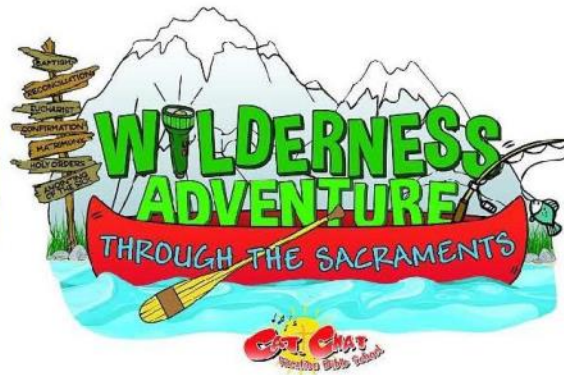

We discussed the happenings of the 121st K of C State convention held in Topeka from April 29th – May 2nd. Council 1832 was awarded honors for top dollar per member for Division #8 for the State Culture of Life Program. Thank You Brother Knights and Thank You Seven Dolors members for supporting our works in achieving this honor. We were also recognized for our efforts with the tootsie roll drive that raises money for Manhattan Special Olympics. Richard and Tanya Bachamp were recognized as District 25 Family of the Year for 2021. It was announced that K of C Supreme council in New Haven Connecticut donated \$200,000 to the Kansas Catholic Conference in support of the efforts to encourage Kansans to vote Yes for the Value Them Both Amendment that will be on the ballot in the mid-term election on August 2, 2022. It was announced that Fr. Brian Lager of the Salina Diocese (currently serving in Colby) will become the next Assistant State Chaplain for the K of C for a 2 year term as of July 1. He will then become State Chaplain for 2 years. We will be joining Kansans for Life and Kansas K of C chaplain Fr. Bernie Gorges in getting the word out to voters on the importance of voting in the Kansas primary on August 2nd. In June / July we will be going door to door of registered voters sharing information about Value Them Both. As we get closer, we will share information on the dates and times of these events, and will invite any parish member who feels called to help in this effort.
