may I always rely on You.

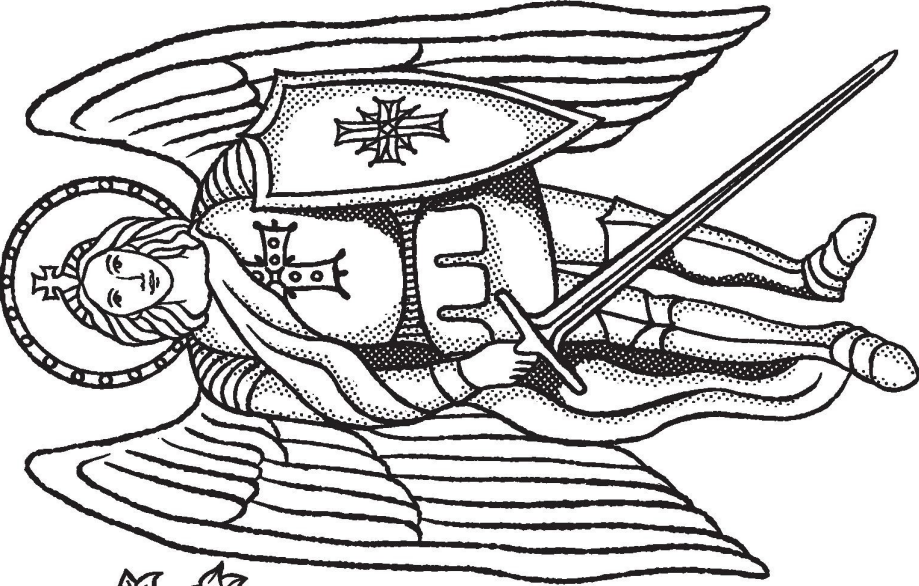
Bless my teachers and my principal too.

a great start.

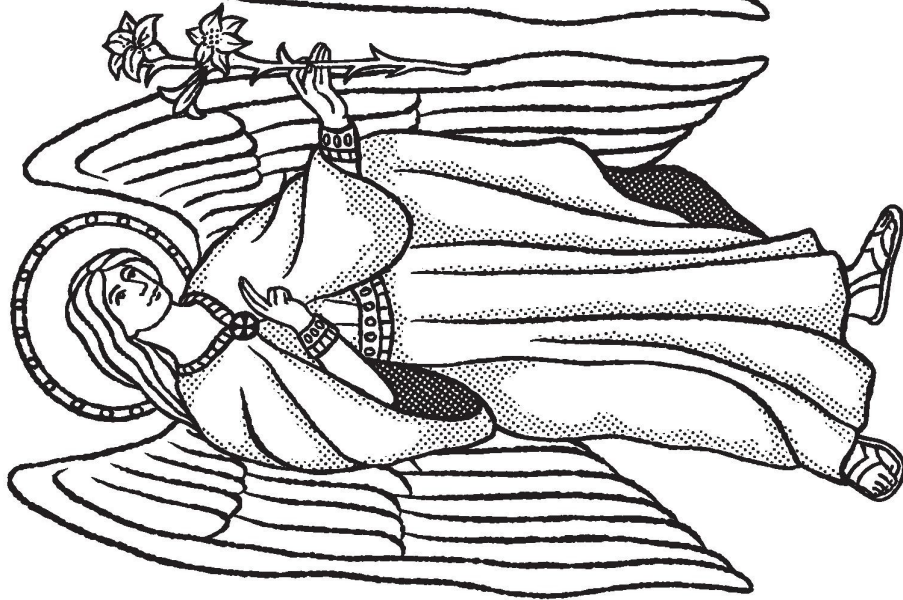
