Friends,

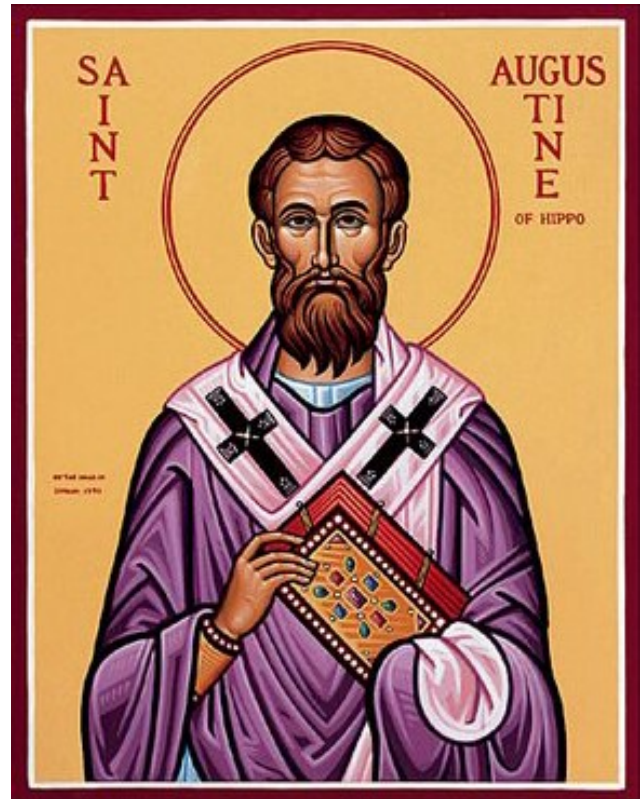
Mark's gospel this week recounts Jesus driving out an unclean spirit from a man in the synagogue. Throughout Mark's gospel, Jesus encounters evil and evil cannot withstand his power. This is a good starting point when considering the problem of evil. Evil cannot withstand the power of Christ.

Augustine's teaching on evil is also helpful. C.S. Lewis explains Augustine's wisdom this way, "God created all things, without exception, good and because they are good, no Nature is bad and the word *bad* denotes merely privation of good... What we call bad things are good things perverted." C.S. Lewis refers to evil as parasitic on good, it requires good to exist, but good does not need evil. All people are in the image of God and, therefore, good. In his ministry, Jesus could see the good in each person, while separating that person from the evil that had become attached to them.

Like Christ, we are called to see people as good. And we also know that in living our lives, the fabric of our life is torn. Some a little, some a lot. The tears let evil into lives of good people. We as Christians are given the mission to mend the cloth of life.
