Friends,

This past week, Bishop Vincke spoke on the Year of Mercy. Among his comments he reflected on the life of Blessed Emilie Travenier-Gamlin of Montreal (1800 – 1851), Foundress of the Sisters of Providence. Inspired by The Seven Sorrows of Mary, Emilie lived a life devoted to the care of the poor. As a widow, she kept what she called, “The Kings Table”. The hungry were always welcome at the King’s Table. The actions of prayer, almsgiving, and fasting enabled her to let go of her sorrows. Reflections on the Seven Sorrows of Mary put into perspective the daily slights which she endured. Her forgiveness came from Our Lady’s grace.

Blessed Emilie’s last words to her religious community were, “Humility, simplicity, charity, above all, charity.” May these words serve us in our Lenten reflections. May they enable us to set our own “Kings Table” for those around us, as the Lord sees fit to call us.

Fasting and Abstinence: Fasting is the act of reducing the daily food we eat. For example, a fast may be one normal meal, reduced portions at other meals and no snacks. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. We are asked to abstain from meat on Lenten Fridays. This is offered as a sign of devotion. These obligations are exempt for the very young, the old, and the infirm. All people can keep these Lenten days prayerful even if they are unable to keep the fast or abstain for health reasons.
