MARCH 10, 2024 + 4TH SUNDAY OF LENT

We are currently halfway through Lent!

It is *Laetare Sunday*, the Fourth Sunday of Lent. The term comes from the beginning of the entrance antiphon (*introit*) for today, it means *rejoice*, and is a relaxation of the penitential character of the Lenten season. Priests and Deacons have the option to wear rose colored vestments.

So how is your Lenten journey at this halfway point? Do you need a day to rejoice because of how hard your Lent has been or do you need a day to remind yourself what Lent is all about and what your why is?

We hear in the Gospel that God loves us so much that He gave us Jesus to die for our sins, to save us, and thus have eternal life. Let this be a reminder as to your why. Why you are going to Mass, why you are giving up things for Lent, why you are trying to live a Christian life.

My prayer is that it can be love. He first loved us and died for our sins. We respond out of love, turn away from our sins, and turn towards Him. Let us rejoice, especially today, in this beautiful life saving Good News and may we be renewed in our Lenten practices for the remainder of the season, out of love.
