JULY 28, 2024 + 17TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Over the next number of weeks, I am going to be discussing the Mass and its parts. I will not have a singular focus, but rather will be trying to cover as many points as possible to help all of us to understand why we do what we do during Mass and what the Church hopes for us to get from our participation in the Mass.

The Church released *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, in English "The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (CSL)", in 1963 to explain the objectives of the Church in expressing the purpose, potential, and the challenges of being a faith based organization in the modern world. The CSL's primary objective is to encourage Full, Conscious (Active), and Faithful participation in the Liturgy (The public duty, or work of the people). All of the changes/updates that occurred in the Novus Ordo (The New Rite) were implemented in order to accomplish this objective. And it is possible for the Novus Ordo to accomplish this, if properly understood and faithfully implemented.

We will start with a story from my childhood that I think most of us young and old can relate to, to give us a stepping off point. When I was in the third grade, we played a number of games during our recess period, tag, kickball, softball and a game new to most of us, Soccer. The rules for tag were pretty simple, and kickball and softball rules were pretty well understood and many of us were active in coached baseball/softball leagues in the summer, but soccer was new to all of us and no one was completely familiar with the rules. We were told that soccer was a game played with the feet (you kicked the ball) and the objective was to get the ball into the goals at opposing ends of the field (for us two fence posts about ten feet apart). Sounds pretty simple right? Well the game is actually much more complicated than that, and most of the world loves to play and watch the sport when it is played as it should be played.

The problem is that in the third grade we did not have all the rules AND we had no one to coach us, to direct us, in how to play the game. As a result, if someone who knew the game well had happened upon our activity and was asked to comment on it, they would have stated that we were playing something similar to what they knew to be soccer, but it was definitely not soccer. Because of the lack of access to the rules and the lack of direction, none of us became world class soccer players, and few of us even developed a real interest in the game that the rest of the world loves so much.

Okay, Fr. Leo, nice story, what does it have to do with Mass? Good question, thanks for asking! I believe that many of the people who have lost interest in the Mass, and those who don't participate in it when they are there, are like those third graders who did not get the rules or the coaching necessary to properly understand what is needed participate completely in the Mass. I, like so many soccer fans around the world do for their sport, yearn to have everyone love the Liturgy, especially the Mass, in the same way that I love it. Arts on the Green will take place on Sunday, September 8th at 4pm on the green space at Juliette and Houston. Music and activities will go until 7pm.

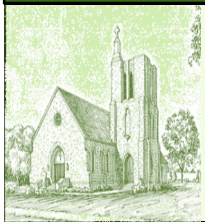
