The Basics of Catholic Public Worship, How We Worship as a Church

Worship is simply giving glory to God for all that He has done for us. As Catholics we are called to worship God in all that we do, but there are times when our entire focus should be on praising God to the exclusion of everything else. We should have several of those moments each day as we enter into our personal prayer time. Christ tells us that at these times we should go into our rooms and pray in private, we should talk to God in an intimate way. He even tells us to call God "Papa" when we address Him privately. These private times are critical to developing our relationship with God. Just as important though are the times that we come together as the body of Christ, The Church, and worship God in a public way. In order for public worship to be the most beneficial, the Church has developed liturgical rituals to help us attain the communal benefits of praying together.

So, how do we pray together as a body? How do we make our prayer unitive? The first way is to have a common posture. The Church, by and large, has adapted her common postures from the Hebrew rites of the Old Testament, and from the Roman postures while in the presence of royalty. These postures include standing, kneeling, sitting and at times laying prostrate on the ground (face down). While in prayer, the traditional position of the hands is folded in front of the Torso with the fingers pointed up to God. These postures can still be seen in all of our common rituals today, most notably in the celebration of Holy Mass. These postures help us to focus on what is occurring. We stand or kneel when we are talking directly to God, or he is speaking directly to us (usually through the Scriptures), kneeling is considered the position of greater reverence. We sit when we are receiving instruction and when we are in a relaxed posture for a time of reflection. It is important that we strive to maintain unity in these postures as much as possible, not because the postures themselves are critical, but because when we act together there are fewer distractions and when we know what to expect, we can focus more on the act of praying and less on whether we are doing what everyone else is doing. By the way, having traveled the world as I have, there is great comfort in being able to walk into a Catholic Church anywhere in the World and recognize that a common ritual is occurring. So we stand kneel, and sit together (as much as physically possible) and we strive not to implement our own preferences into our public rituals for the sake of our own humility and for the benefit of those around us who are focused on prayer. There is much more that could be said here, but for the purpose of brevity, we will save a broader discussion for a later date.
