The Basics of Catholic Public Worship: Where We Worship

As we said last week, worship is simply giving glory to God for all that He has done for us.

Now for the Question where do we worship? Obviously we can pray to God anywhere and everywhere, but whenever possible our public worship should be in a place dedicated to God where the proper structures and atmosphere are available for giving Glory to God. So, while we can have Holy Mass outside or in a stadium when necessary, if a Church is available that can accommodate the needs, public worship should be in a Church with the proper ornamentation to accomplish the desired ritual. Holy Mass and the Sacraments, when publicly celebrated, should (whenever possible) always be in a (Catholic) Church.

It might also be helpful to be familiar with some of the terminology that relates to locations in the church. Of course the term church, when speaking of a structure, is the entire building. The term Sanctuary is the place where the Sacred Actions take place, and it should be reserved for that. Thus there should always be great reverence when in the Sanctuary. Also, any ornamentation in the Sanctuary should point us to those Sacred Actions, there should be nothing secular with in the Sanctuary. In modern churches the Sanctuary usually includes the nave, because there is no barrier between the altar/tabernacle/ambo and the nave. Most places where this is the case differentiate between the Sacred Space where the offerings are made (the space around the alter and the ambo) and the nave (the worship space for the people, in modern churches, this is where the pews are located). Finally, there is the narthex, or gathering space, a place outside of the Sanctuary (usually at the entrance of the Church) for the people to come together, to greet each other, to get reacquainted, etc. (visiting and discussion should remain outside the Sanctuary whenever possible.)
