The Parts of the Holy Mass

The Roman Missal is the official document for the Church that relates to the Holy Mass. The current Missal promulgated in 2002 and latest (3rd) revision was released in 2011. The Missal contains all of the prayers used in the Mass and the rubrics instructing priests on their actions inside the Mass. More important for this set of articles is the “General Instructions” (GIRM) included in the front of the Missal along with several other “norms” that we may touch on here.

In its opening paragraphs, the GIRM quotes Sacrosanctum Concilium when it says, “It is, therefore, of the greatest importance that the celebration of the Mass or the Lord’s Supper be so ordered that the sacred ministers and the faithful taking part in it, according to the state proper to each, may draw from it more abundantly those fruits, to obtain which, Christ the Lord instituted the Eucharistic Sacrifice of his Body and Blood and entrusted it as the memorial of his Passion and Resurrection to the Church, his beloved Bride.” So, the intent is for us to draw from the abundant fruits Christ gave to us. To do so, we must participate to the fullest extent that we are capable. The use of the vernacular (common) language is encouraged to assist this.

According to the GIRM there are four parts to the Mass (two primary and two minor), they are: the Introductory Rite, the Liturgy of the Word, the Liturgy of the Eucharist, and the Concluding Rite. Everything that we do in the Mass points us to Christ and is ordered toward our reception of the “Word of God”, that is Jesus Christ, both in the form of Scripture and in the Blessed Sacrament. Within the action we are called to, and elevated into, the Heavenly Realm.

Caregiver Support Group

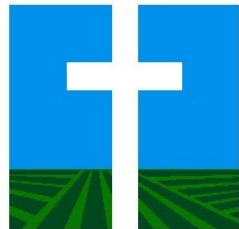
