‡**Feeding the Hungry:** Common Table is the name for a gathering of a number of Manhattan Churches who organize to feed the hungry. On each evening of the week and two mornings, about 70-80 people of need gather at one of the downtown churches to eat a prepared meal. For many years, our Seven Dolors parish assisted with a Friday morning breakfast at the Episcopal church and we still make a monthly financial contribution. Common Table also provides a "Christmas gift" to the folks who come to the meals. Our parish was asked to provide 100 bottles of fragrance free deodorant. We invite you to bring one of any size to the office between now and the first of December. We feel blessed to work with the other downtown churches and we are grateful to all who assist them and us.

‡**Ministry of Care Update:** The Seven Dolors Ministry of Care through its priests and lay volunteers wishes to serve the spiritual needs of parishioners who are hospitalized, homebound, or in a care facility with Communion, Anointing, or a visit or call. Federal law now prevents hospitals and care home employees from disclosing the presence of any patient to outsiders, even Church ministers, unless the patient or their caregiver has signed a HIPPA release form.

A family member, relative, or friend must let us know about any changes. If you know about an ill or hospitalized parishioner that we may not have, please call the Parish Office: 785-565-5000, and Margie will pass it on to the appropriate priest.

Element Highlight

Starting this week, we will attempt to highlight a different element of the newly renovated church and tell you a little bit about its history and meaning.

This week's selection is the crucifix that can be seen above the tabernacle. Fr Kerry shared with the Eucharistic Ministers that this particular crucifix has ties to not only Seven Dolors, but also a particular parishioner.

Dale Anderson was a young boy and in charge of carrying the processional cross into the church at the beginning of Mass each week. This cross was used since the church opened in 1920! Dale said that he also carried it during the ceremony of the laying of Luckey building's corner stone with Monsignor Luckey. When the renovations began in 1968 and a new cross was selected to use for the processions, Dale saved this one.

He had the corpus re-silvered and the cross polished and it was kept at the Anderson home until he donated it back to the church when we began our renovations.

Thank you to Dale for all of his hard work locating original items and donating those he had to our project!
