## **Element Highlight**

It is time again for another Element Highlight. This week's selection is what is known as the Ambry.

In Roman Catholic usage, when commonly called an ambry, it is traditionally in the sanctuary (as in, the altar area) of a church or in the Baptistry, and is used to store the oils used in sacraments: Oil of Catechumens (indicated by the Latin letters O.C.), Oil of the Sick (O.I.), and Sacred Chrism (S.C.). Before the Second Vatican Council, regulations required it to be secured and locked, and lined and veiled with either purple cloth (in reference to the Oil of the Sick) or white (for the Sacred Chrism). The door was usually marked "O.S." or Olea Sancta (Holy Oils), to indicate the contents. Such regulations are now relaxed so that while many churches continue to use such an ambry, the oils are also stored and in some cases displayed in other ways. The locked Ambry in our newly renovated church is located at the back of the church, by the confessional, and closer to the baptismal font.

Thanks to a member of the BHS Construction crew who donated his personal time & materials, we now have this wonderful new Ambry.
